### 2023 Picnic Shelter/Athletic Field Reservations

Reservations for the picnic shelters in the Town of Dyer parks are accepted in person on a first-come, first-served basis, during business hours starting in January for the same calendar year. A reservation guarantees the shelter availability for the day desired. Town ordinance also requires any group of 15 or more people must have a permit to use the parks.

Full Payment (fee + deposit) in the form of cash, check or credit cards are accepted to hold the date and is non-refundable. The 7% Indiana General Sales Tax is added to the fees below but not to the clean-up and damage deposit. Shelters are typically available for reservations between May 15 - October 15. All shelters have electricity available. Plus all rentals pay a refundable clean up & damage deposit of Resident \$100/Non Resident \$150.00. Refunded upon Park Board approval if cleanup has occurred and no damage was done.

### Park Rules

- Parks are open from Dawn until Dusk (unless authorized by permit or Parks and Recreation Activity).
- Pets are allowed in town parks according to posted restrictions. They
  must be leashed and cleaned up after. Owners are responsible for their
  pets.
- Motorized vehicles are prohibited in parks except in designated parking areas.
- No alcohol is allowed (unless authorized by permit).
- Golfing is not allowed in parks.
- No littering or dumping of household garbage or yard waste.
- Fishing is not allowed at Pheasant Hills Park pond.
- All town ordinances will be strictly enforced.
- Groups of 15 or more require a permit.

Park rules are enforced by the Dyer Police Dept.

### Thor Guard Lightning Prediction & Warning System

Once Lightning is predicted, the main satellite will send a signal to the remote satellite and you will hear a 15 second horn blast. This signals that lightning is coming to the area. At that time, everyone should seek shelter and all outdoor activities should stop. A strobe light will begin to flash & remain flashing until safe conditions return. Once lightning is cleared from the area, you will hear three 5 second horn blasts signaling all is safe and outdoor activities can resume.

The Thor Guard System will be active between the hours of 10 am - 8 pm, Monday - Friday & 9 am - 8 pm on Saturdays & Sundays, roughly March - October. For more information about the system visit



#### **Refund Policy**

All refund requests must be made in writing prior to the rental reservation date and submitted <u>during regular business hours.</u> Any refunds will be considered at the next monthly Park Board meeting, and upon approval, will be mailed to the customer in the form of a check. Refunds take approximately 3 -6 weeks to process.

#### **Facility Rentals**

- Facility rentals that are cancelled 14 days or more in advance of the rental date will receive a full refund minus a \$10.00 administrative fee.
- Facility rentals that are cancelled between three-thirteen days in advance of the rental date will receive a full refund of the clean-up and damage deposit and 50% refund of the rental fees.
- Facility rentals that are cancelled 48 hours or less in advance of the rental date will receive a full refund of the clean-up and damage deposit but will not receive any
  refund of the rental fees.
- Once the date of reservation has passed, no refunds will be given for facility rentals.
- Any facility cancellations made by the Town of Dyer Parks and Recreation department will cause a 100% full refund to the renter with no administrative fee.
- Refund requests for non-use of facility due to documented medical emergency or death will be considered on an individual basis taking into consideration the
  expenses incurred by the Park Department.

#### **Recreation Programs and Trips:**

- No refunds will be given for trips unless the seat can be resold. If it can be resold, a refund will be made subject to a service charge of \$5.00.
- Class cancellations made by the Parks and Recreation Department will result 100% refund that will be mailed to the customer. If the customer is a minor, the refund will go to the Parent/Guardian who signs the registration form. If you wish to apply this refund to another class, you must notify the Parks and Recreation Department immediately.
- Refund requests received 5 or more business days before the first class meeting will be approved, less a service charge of \$5.00.
- If a refund request is received **less than 5 business days** prior to the start of a class and it causes enrollment to fall below the minimum and the vacancy cannot be filled; no refund will be given. If enrollment does not fall below the minimum, a refund will be given less a service charge of \$5.00.
- Refund requests received after the start of a class shall be denied except that such a refund request based upon a medical doctor's written excuse submitted prior
  to completion of the class will result in a pro-rated refund (except as hereinafter provided) based upon the number of classes held prior to the date of the refund
  request, less a \$5.00 service charge and program supply costs. If such a refund request causes a class to fall below the minimum number required, and the vacancy
  cannot be filled, no refund will be given.
- All recreation program refunds applied for are subject to a \$5.00 service charge, except that fee of \$10.00 or less shall be subject to a service charge equal to 10% of the fee. This policy was adopted 2/9/2011 by the Park Board.

### Resident Financial Aid Program

Because some residents are unable to participate in our programs due to economic hardship, the Dyer Parks & Recreation Department is offering financial aid to offset certain fees and charges. The ice rink will bee installed at Central Park. This rink is 40' x 80' and will be used when the weather allows the ice to completely freeze. Residents will be able to enjoy the rink from mid-December to mid-March, The rink will be lit most nights. The ice rink will be open from dawn to dusk, during normal park hours. Restrooms will be open during this time.

- Only ice skates are allowed on the ice surface.
- No hockey games, hockey sticks, hockey equipment, or nets are allowed.
- Proper protective skating equipment is highly recommended.
- Kicking holes, chipping, or gouging in the ice is strictly forbidden.
- Any behavior that poses a risk to other skaters' safety is strictly prohibited.
- ♦ The ice-skating rink is closed when ice is not completely frozen due to higher temperatures or other conditions.
- ◆ This is an open ice rink for **Dyer residents** to enjoy. All persons using the ice rink recognize and assume all risk in using it.
