## 2022 Picnic Shelter/Athletic Field Reservations

Reservations for the picnic shelters in the Town of Dyer parks are accepted in person on a first-come, first-served basis, during business hours starting in January for the same calendar year. A reservation guarantees the shelter availability for the day desired. Town ordinance also requires any group of 15 or more people must have a permit to use the parks. Full Payment (fee + deposit) in the form of cash, check or credit cards are accepted to hold the date and is non-refundable. The 7% Indiana General Sales Tax is added to the fees below but not to the clean-up and damage deposit. Shelters are typically available for reservations between May 15 - October 15. All shelters have electricity available. Plus all rentals pay a refundable clean up & damage deposit of \$50.00. Refunded upon Park Board approval if cleanup has occurred and no damage was done.

## **Dyer Dog Park**

Located at Central Park, the three acre facility includes a small dog area and a large dog area, complete with benches and dog waste stations.

The dog park is open daily from dawn to dusk 365 days a year.

Each area of the park includes its own water fountain for the dogs (but is only on seasonally during the warmer times of the year).

Individuals and their dogs visiting the dog park must be registered at the Dyer Town Hall Parks and Recreation office.

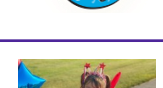

### Living Tree & Park Bench Memorials

## Park Rules

- Parks are open from Dawn until Dusk (unless authorized by permit or Parks and Recreation Activity).
- Pets are allowed in town parks according to posted restrictions. They must be leashed and cleaned up after. Owners are responsible for their pets.
- Motorized vehicles are prohibited in parks except in designated parking areas.
- No alcohol is allowed (unless authorized by permit).
- Golfing is not allowed in parks.
- No littering or dumping of household garbage or yard waste.
- Fishing is not allowed at Pheasant Hills Park pond.
- All town ordinances will be strictly enforced.
- Groups of 15 or more require a permit.

Park rules are enforced by the Dyer Police Dept.

If you see someone vandalizing or violating these rules, please call 911

### Thor Guard Lightning Prediction & Warning System

Once Lightning is predicted, the main satellite will send a signal to the remote satellite and you will hear a 15 second horn blast. This signals that lightning is coming to the area. At that time, everyone should seek shelter and all outdoor activities should stop. A strobe light will begin to flash & remain flashing until safe conditions return. Once lightning is cleared from the area, you will hear three 5 second horn blasts signaling all is safe and outdoor activities can resume.

The Thor Guard System will be active between the hours of 10 am - 8 pm, Monday - Friday & 9 am - 8 pm on Saturdays & Sundays, roughly March - October. 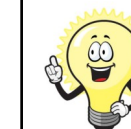

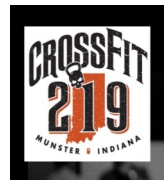

# General Information

## Refund Policy

All refund requests must be made in writing prior to the rental reservation date and submitted during regular business hours. Any refunds will be considered at the next monthly Park Board meeting, and upon approval, will be mailed to the customer in the form of a check. Refunds take approximately 3 -6 weeks to process.

### Facility Rentals:

- Facility rentals that are cancelled **14 days or more** in advance of the rental date will receive a full refund minus a \$10.00 administrative fee.
- Facility rentals that are cancelled between **thirteen days in advance of the rental date** will receive a full refund of the clean-up and damage deposit and 50% refund of the rental fees.
- Facility rentals that are cancelled **48 hours or less in advance of the rental date** will receive a full refund of the clean-up and damage deposit but will not receive any refund of the rental fees.
- Once the date of reservation has passed, no refunds will be given for facility rentals.
- Any facility cancellations made by the Town of Dyer Parks and Recreation department will cause a 100% full refund to the renter with no administrative fee.
- Refund requests for non-use of facility due to documented medical emergency or death will be considered on an individual basis taking into consideration the expenses incurred by the Park Department.

### Recreation Programs and Trips:

- No refunds will be given for **trips** unless the seat can be resold. If it can be resold, a refund will be made subject to a service charge of \$5.00.
- **Class cancellations** made by the Parks and Recreation Department will result 100% refund that will be mailed to the customer. If the customer is a minor, the refund will go to the Parent/Guardian who signs the registration form. If you wish to apply this refund to another class, you must notify the Parks and Recreation Department immediately.
- Refund requests **received 5 or more business days before** the first class meeting will be approved, less a service charge of \$5.00.
- If a refund request is received **less than 5 business days** prior to the start of a class and it causes enrollment to fall below the minimum and the vacancy cannot be filled; no refund will be given. If enrollment does not fall below the minimum, a refund will be given less a service charge of \$5.00.
- **Refund requests received after the start of a class shall be denied** except that such a refund request based upon a medical doctor's written excuse submitted prior to completion of the class will result in a pro-rated refund (except as hereinafter provided) based upon the number of classes held prior to the date of the refund request, less a \$5.00 service charge and program supply costs. If such a refund request causes a class to fall below the minimum number required, and the vacancy cannot be filled, no refund will be given.
- All recreation program and trip refunds applied for are subject to a **\$5.00 service charge**, except that fee of \$10.00 or less shall be subject to a service charge equal to 10% of the fee. *This policy was adopted 2/9/2011 by the Park Board.*

## Resident Financial Aid Program

Because some residents are unable to participate in our programs due to economic hardship, the Dyer Parks & Recreation Department is offering financial aid to offset certain fees and charges. Financial aid applications can be obtained at the Dyer Parks and Recreation office Monday - Friday from 7:30 am - 4:00 pm or online at parks.townofdyer.com. ## New Skating Rinks



### Northgate Park Ice Rink Rules

A new this year, the ice rink has been installed at Northgate Park. This rink is 40' x 80' and will be used when the weather allows the ice to completely freeze. Residents will be able to enjoy the rink from mid-December to mid-March, The pavilion will be lit most nights. The ice rink will be open from dawn to dusk, during normal park hours. Restrooms will be closed at this time.

- ◆ Only ice skates are allowed on the ice surface.
- ◆ No hockey games, hockey sticks, hockey equipment, or nets are allowed.
- ◆ Proper protective skating equipment is highly recommended.
- ◆ Kicking holes, chipping, or gouging in the ice is strictly forbidden.
- ◆ Any behavior that poses a risk to other skaters' safety is strictly prohibited.
- ◆ The ice-skating rink is closed when ice is not completely frozen due to higher temperatures or other conditions.
- ◆ This is an open ice rink for Dyer residents to enjoy. All persons using the ice rink recognize and assume all risk in using it.
- ◆ The ice rink is not staffed. To report any issues during park hours, 7:30 - 4:00 pm Monday - Friday, please contact the Dyer Parks and Recreation Department at (219) 865-2505.
- ◆ All current park rules will apply when using the ice rink.

### Central Park Synthetic Ice Rink Rules

Synthetic ice tiles have been placed under the pavilion. Residents will be able to enjoy the rink from mid-December to mid-March. The pavilion will be lit most nights. This is a small surface and regular ice skates must be worn when using this rink. The ice rink will be open from dawn to dusk, during normal park hours. Restrooms will be closed at this time.

- ◆ Only ice skates are allowed on the synthetic ice surface.
- ◆ The synthetic ice-skating rink is not real ice, but are 18" x 18" tiles that resemble ice. Each tile is very slick. All participants must use appropriate caution when using the synthetic ice rink.
- ◆ No hockey games, hockey sticks, hockey equipment, or hockey nets are allowed, this surface is meant for skating only.
- ◆ Proper protective skating equipment is highly recommended.
- ◆ Kicking holes, chipping, gouging, or removing the synthetic ice tiles is strictly forbidden.
- ◆ Any behavior that poses a risk to other skaters' safety is strictly prohibited.
- ◆ The synthetic ice can be used in above-freezing temperatures; however, the rink is closed during inclement weather, including rain and snow.
- ◆ This is an open synthetic ice rink for Dyer residents to enjoy. All persons using the synthetic ice rink recognize and assume all risk in using it.
- ◆ The ice rink is not staffed. To report any issues during park hours, 7:30 - 4:00 pm Monday - Friday, please contact the Dyer Parks and Recreation Department at (219) 865-2505.
- ◆ All current park rules will apply when using the synthetic ice rink.

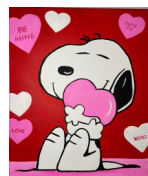

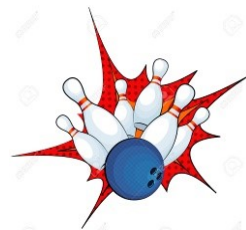
