Department of Public Works, Dumpster Usage

There is a dumpster available for town residents at the Department of Public Works. This is available for use between the hours of 7:00am to 3:00pm, Monday thru Friday.

To use the dumpster, please follow these rules:

1. Check-in at the DPW Administration Office before heading to the dumpster.
2. Proof of town residency is required. Identification must be shown at the time of usage.
3. If you have any of the following items, you will not be able to use the dumpster:
 - Hazardous Waste, Oil or Gasoline Products
 - Unused Paint
 - Roofing Materials
 - Railroad Ties
 - Lawn Waste
 - Landscaping Materials
 - Bricks, Concrete, Stone, or Gravel
 - Automotive Parts and Batteries
 - Propane or Helium Tanks
 - Kitchen Appliances
 - Dehumidifiers/Humidifiers
 - Trash Compactors
 - Washing Machines
 - Household Dryers
 - Water Heaters

Once you have completed the check-in process, park your vehicle near the dumpster and dispose of your items inside the dumpster. Please do not place anything on the ground.

Contractors and business are not allowed to use this dumpster and a **maximum of one load** per residence is allowed each 30 days. Cars, pick-up trucks or one pull behind trailer with no waste inside the main vehicle will be allowed.

Also, there is a separate dumpster available for anyone within Lake County for tires. This is recycled by the County.
